We have a wide range of strings, woodwind and brass instruments available for loan. Information on instrument loan is available from the Music Department.

Occurrence

Approximately, 32 Music Lessons are spread across the school year. Music Lessons are created into a SET TIMETABLE. For Example, lessons are held on the SAME day and time in *Week A* and in *Week B*. Our aim is to give all students 8 x instrumental music lessons per term. Year 11 and 12 students will receive less than normal lessons in Term 4 due to the VCE Exams.

***Note:** Student's SET music lesson times may be subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances in a given term.

Enrolment

Upon receiving your completed enrolment form, you will receive confirmation of enrolment via email. The music department will contact the student and parents/guardians via email informing them of their first lesson day, time and venue. **Once a student is enrolled, enrolment is automatically rolled-over term to term until the end of the school year, unless withdrawn.**

Scholarships

Year 7 Students

Mount Lilydale Mercy College awards eight (8) FULL Instrumental Music Scholarships to Year 7 students who are enrolled into private or group lessons in Semester 1, 2024. Year 7 students commencing in 2024 DO NOT need to audition for a Music Scholarship. At the end of Term 2, selected students will be offered a FULL Music Scholarship for Semester 2 in 2024 based on their attendance, commitment and their progress in the Instrumental Music Program during Semester 1.

Year 8 to 12 Students

16 Instrumental Music Scholarships which are equal to half the fees of private instrumental lessons for the year are available to students in Years 8-12.
