- The academic standard of the recipient should be such that he/she is able to take full advantage of the subjects provided by Mount Lilydale Mercy College.
- Commitment to the Catholic faith must be displayed.
- The recipient should embrace the Mercy ethos, reveal a positive school spirit as well as a desire to work for the overall good of the College whilst as a student and later as an Old Collegian.
- Evidence of participation in community-based activities such as social justice, music, public speaking, sport or drama.

An interview will be conducted with a panel of the Principal, Deputy Principal – Pastoral Care, President of the Old Collegians and the Community Development Coordinator. Consideration may be given to a student experiencing financial hardship. Interviews will be conducted in late November and the Scholarship awarded on the Night of Excellence or at a later date.
