

# Mount Lilydale Mercy College Bushfire Emergency Policy

#### 1. RATIONALE

- 1.1. While the threat of bushfire to Mount Lilydale Mercy College (MLMC) property is unlikely there needs to be procedures in place should such a situation develop either at the College or at camp / excursion venues.
- 1.2. As many students travel on school buses to and from rural areas there also needs to be a procedure in place should there be bushfire threat along bus routes.

#### 2. SCOPE

- 2.1. This document and the accompanying Implementation Guidelines apply to all staff and students.
- 2.2. The policy provides guidance and procedures for ensuring the safety of students and staff in the case of impending bushfire and on extreme or catastrophic bushfire risk days.

#### 4. POLICY STATEMENT

4.1. It is policy that the College is prepared to respond to any threat of bushfire – to College property, to school bus routes and to venues of off-site activity. Procedures are in place to protect the safety of all students and staff.

5.1. The safety of all members of the College community is paramount and to that end the College will be fire ready.
